MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION
OF

I. NAME OF THE SOCIETY:

Name of the Society shall be "SRI RAM GODURDHIN CHARITABLE TRUST"

II. REGISTERED OFFICE:

The Registered office of the Society shall be situated in the National Capital Territory of Delhi. Until the Governing Body decide otherwise from time to time, the office of the Society shall be located at:

C-15, CHIRAG ENCLAVE,
NEW DELHI - 110048.

III(A). AIMS & OBJECTIVES:

The aims and objectives for which Society is established shall be as under:


1. The promotion of charitable and non-religious objects and purposes which will be or is intended to advance the well-being and welfare of the people of India without distinction as to colour, caste, community, creed, sex or political belief.
2. To arrange and provide or otherwise assist any institution in provision of medical aid and such other assistance necessary for living to the needy persons who are otherwise incapable or handicapped or mentally or physically retarded and financially uplift any person of poor class.
3. To arrange, provide or otherwise assist any institution in provision of social, moral and financial assistance for betterment of life and any unmarried girl or boy, widow or widower from time to time.
4. To provide or otherwise assist any organisation in providing funding, clothing, shelter or medical aid for the welfare of victims of natural calamities or to persons or families of the persons who are for any reason incapable of providing for themselves at times of need, either free or for nominal charges.

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5. To assist leper asylums or other institutions for helping the poor destitutes, widows or orphans of all faiths and communities.
 6. To propagate, impart and adopt any audio-visual methods for the promotion of art, science or any other field of education.
 7. To accept donations and to invest the funds of the Society as per the existing laws in force, for providing income to the Society on such terms and conditions as may deem proper and necessary for the fulfilment of the aims and objects of the trust.
 8. To undertake, facilitate and provide for the publication of news letters, research papers, house magazine and books and of a journal for the exposition of the objects of the Society.
 9. To establish and maintain libraries to facilitate the study in the fields of education, cultures, religion and such other fields as considered fit for the public benefit.
 10. To cooperate with approved institutions and interested bodies for the furtherance of the objects of the Society.
 11. To issue appeals and applications for monies/fund for the furtherance of the said objects and to accept gifts, donations and subscriptions of cash and securities of any property either movable or immovable and by other ways; or mode of collecting the same efforts.
 12. To establish, construct, organize, consolidate, maintain, develop, acquire, if ever, conduct, equip, endow, improve, alter, extend, minister and administer institution or their branches in India or any part thereof, irrespective of caste, creed, age, religion and community.
 13. To start, takeover, establish, support, maintain and administer hostels for students, staff members, employees and other personnel connected with the work of the Society.
 14. To actively participate in relief work for community in the affected area(s) during the natural calamities like flood, drought, earthquake, fire, epidemic and alike.
 15. To work actively to generate awareness against AIDS, dowry, drug addiction, exploitation of weaker section (women, children and bonded labourer). It will play a key role to eradicate such social menaces and providing rehabilitation centres. The Centre will provide to community different welfare schemes of Government and other agencies.
 16. To do other such acts, which aid things for the progress and development of the aims and objectives of the Society.





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**III (B) THE ANCILLARY OBJECTS OF THE SOCIETY, IN FURTHERANCE AND
PROMOTION OF THE AFORESAID MAIN OBJECTS:**

1. To receive and collect any gift, subscriptions, grant and donations either in cash or in any kind, or acquired by any other lawful ways and means and spend the same in fulfilment of all or any of the aims and objectives of the Society. The income and property(s) of the Society shall be applied solely for the promotion and fulfilment of the aims and objects of the Society, provided if any donor intends that the contributions, donations or subscriptions shall be applied to attain any particular objects of the Society, such contributions, donations, subscriptions shall be spent towards the promotion of that particular object only.
2. To acquire by purchase, take on lease, hire or by gift, and hold any movable or immovable properties of any rights, or privileges that may be deemed necessary or useful for the advancement of the objects of the Society.
3. All the incomes, earnings, movable, immovable properties of the Society shall be solely utilised and applied towards the promotion of its aims and objects only as set forth in the Memorandum of Association and no profit on them shall be made or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividends, bonus, profits or in any manner whatsoever to the present or past members of the Society or to any persons claiming through anyone or more of the present or past members. No member of the Society shall have any personal claim on any movable or immovable properties of the Society or make any profits, whatsoever by virtue of his / her membership.



RULES AND REGULATIONS

SRI RAM "OUDHUN CHARITABJU" TRUST

MEMBERSHIP :

Members of the Society shall be those individuals of Indian nation who have attained the age of majority and fulfil the terms and conditions of the Society without discrimination of religion, caste, colour or creed, when the Governing Body shall so decide. They shall be members of the Society until they die, or declared incompetent, resign, become bankrupt or are removed under these Rules.

SUBSCRIPTIONS :

- (i) Admission fees Rs. 100/- (Rupees One Hundred Only) at the time of admission.
- (ii) Annual subscriptions: The amount shall be decided by the Governing Body from time to time.

TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP

The Governing Body shall have the power to expel a member from the Society on the following terms and conditions:

- (a) By no confidence motion passed by 2/3rd majority of votes in the General Body meeting.
- (b) On his/her written resignation.
- (c) He/She has not attended three consecutive meetings of the General Body without any intimation/leave of absence.

The reason of termination from membership shall be communicated to the member concerned in writing.

APPEALS :

All the appeals should be referred to the General Body of the Society. The decision of the General Body shall be final. The reason for objection shall be communicated to the member concerned.

5. **READMISSION:**

In case a member is expelled by the General Body the same can be re-admitted provided the concerned member pays the admission fees afresh.

6. **GENERAL BODY:**

The General Body of the Society shall consist of all members of the Society whose names exist on the rolls one week before the scheduled Annual General Meeting of the members.

7. (A) **ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING:**

The General Body shall meet at least once a year, at a meeting which would be called the Annual General Meeting, at such place and time as the Governing Body may decide, and as specified in the notice of the meeting, to conduct among others, the following business:

- (i) To receive and approve the Annual Accounts, the Audit Report, Report of the Activities of the Society from the Governing Body.
- (ii) To elect persons to fill vacancies on the Governing Body in place of such members of the Body whose terms are expiring by show of hands or by secret ballot paper as required.
- (iii) To consider any other matter that may be brought to the attention of members in the notice of the meeting or by permission of the Chairman of the meeting.

7. (B) **EXTRA-ORDINARY GENERAL MEETING:**

Extra-Ordinary General Meeting shall be convened at such place and time as the Governing Body may decide, and as specified in the Notice of the meeting, to conduct the following business:

- (i) To fill casual vacancies which have arisen due to death, resignation or incapacity of members of the Governing Body.
- (ii) To consider any other matter that may be brought to the attention of members in the notice of the meeting or by permission of the Chairman of the meeting.

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8. **GOVERNING BODY:**

The Governing Body shall consist of not less than seven members and not more than thirteen members and the composition of the Governing Body shall be as under:-

9. **BANK ACCOUNT:**

The bank accounts of the Society shall be operated by the President and Secretary/Treasurer.

10. **SOURCES OF INCOME:**

- (i) Admission fees.
- (ii) Subscriptions.
- (iii) Donations and special contributions.

The income of the Society received from all sources will be used only for the promotion of the aims and objects of the Society.

11. **MEETING OF THE GOVERNING BODY:**

The meeting of the Governing Body shall be held as and when necessary for which seven days clear notice will be required and the quorum shall be two third members of the Governing Body present or three whichever is higher.

12. **ELECTION AND QUORUM:**

The General Body in its annual meeting will elect its President and all the office bearers and members after Five Years by show of hands or by secret ballot paper as required. The quorum of the General Body shall be 3 or 2/3 members of the General Body present whichever is higher.

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ALL INFORMATION IS FOR OFFICIAL USE ONLY

13. FUNCTIONS OF THE GOVERNING BODY:

- (a) To arrange finance if required from the bank(s), institutions or individuals on reasonable terms and conditions and the Governing Body as a whole shall be liable for its return.
- (b) The Governing Body shall make plan for the future programmes of the Society.
- (c) To publish literature and to propagate the systems, to approach the public pertaining to upliftments of status of the Society.
- (d) To appoint, terminate and fix duties of any staff.
- (e) Governing Body shall meet atleast once in a quarter.
- (f) To accept, donations, charities, loans, grants, properties, etc. from public, other associations, agencies, government departments in the interest of the promotion of aims and objectives of the Society.

14. MANAGEMENT OF FUNDS:

All the income of the Society shall be deposited in the Schedule-Bank and shall be utilised for the purpose of the Society.

15.(A) REGISTER OF MEMBERS:

The Society shall maintain at its registered office, a Register of its members and shall enter therein following particulars:

- (a) The names and addresses of the members.
- (b) The date on which the member was admitted.
- (c) The date on which a member ceased to be a member.

15.(B) RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF THE MEMBERS:

Each and every member of the Society :

- (a) shall have one vote at every general meeting.
- (b) shall be entitled to participate in the general meetings and the gathering of the society.

- (c) shall have right to inspect the books of accounts, minutes of proceedings of the general body meeting in any working day during working hours by giving reasonable notice;
- (d) shall be bound by the Rules & Regulations and / or bye laws which may be framed from time to time; and
- (e) to administer the oath of the office and loyalty of the society and / or its constitution to the President

16. POWER AND DUTIES OF THE OFFICE BEARERS :

(A) PRESIDENT :

- (a) He / she shall supervise all works and activities done by other office bearers of the society.
- (b) He / She will be the head of society and preside over the meetings of the General Body and Governing Body. He will have the right of casting vote.

(B) SECRETARY :

- (a) To sign on behalf of the society, conduct its correspondence and to receive the proceedings of the meetings.
- (b) To summon and attend the meeting of the General Body.
- (c) To call Ordinary General Body Meeting if desired on written request of at least 1/3rd members of the General Body.

(C) TREASURER :

He / She shall keep accounts of receipts and expenditure of the society and to furnish the necessary information to the Governing Body.

17. COMPENSATION AND REMUNERATION :

The members of the Governing Board shall be entitled to reimbursement of expenses incurred in the performance of their duties. Nothing herein shall preclude a member of the Governing Body from serving the society in any other capacity and receiving compensation, remuneration, fees or honorarium for such services.

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18. AUDIT :

The account of the Society shall be audited at least once in a year by a qualified auditor appointed by the Governing Body.

19. FINANCIAL YEAR :

The financial year of the Society shall start from the 1st day of April to 31st Day of March every year.

20. TENURE OF THE GOVERNING BODY :

The tenure of the Governing Body shall be five years.

21. AMENDMENT :

Any amendment in the Memorandum of Association and Rules and Regulations will be carried out in accordance with the section 12 and 13 of the Societies Registration Act of 1860, as applicable to the National Capital Territory of Delhi.

22. LEGAL PROCEEDINGS (SECTION 6 OF THE ACT) :

The Society may sue or be sued in the name of the President as per provisions laid down under section 6 of the Societies Registration Act, 1860, as applicable to the National Capital Territory of Delhi.

23. ANNUAL LIST OF GOVERNING BODY :

Once in every year a list of the office bearers and members of the Governing Body shall be filed with the Registrar of Societies, N. C. T of Delhi as required under section 4 of the Societies Registration Act 1860, and applicable to the National Capital Territory of Delhi.

24. DISSOLUTION :

If the society needs to be dissolved it shall be dissolved as per provisions laid down under section 13 and 14 of the Societies Registration Act 1860, as applicable to the National Capital Territory of Delhi. If upon the dissolution of the Society there shall remain after the satisfaction of its debts and liabilities any property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid to or distributed among the members of the Society but shall be given over to organisations with comparable purposes according to the decisions of the members or, in default thereof, according to the decision of a competent court.
